Logic Model

Step 1: A group of district leaders meet to discuss their goals for increasing student achievement with the Center for Innovative Education and Prevention. The district leaders will explore the opportunity to work with the center to provide an integrated approach to professional learning.

Step 2: The Center for Innovative Education and Prevention will provide a keynote presentation for educators and other stakeholders to share the learning opportunity.

Step 3: Principals meet with center personnel to discuss how the center will assist teachers and teacher leaders to move toward their vision for the school within the broader community.

Step 4: The Center for Innovative Education and Prevention hosts a follow-up meeting with teachers interested in taking part in a program of professional learning with a focus on becoming more effective classroom instructors and teacher leaders.

Step 5: Quarterly meetings with core implementation team and the center for purposes of Q and A, planning, or celebrating small steps. These meetings may be either virtual, for example, via Skype or live.

Step 6: Teachers who have participated in professional learning events with CIEP provide model classrooms, local professional development, and mentoring of colleagues. Furthermore, they develop lesson plans with colleagues in key core content areas.

Step 7: An impact study of outcomes relating to teacher effectiveness will be provided by the center.

Step 8: At the end of the year there will be a celebration of results, graduation, and planning for next year.
